All Stocks exhibited for premiums (Entires excepted, and which must have been owned at least one year by the competitor) must have been raised in the County; and all Stock exhibited that has not been raised by the competitor, must have been owned by him exclusively for not less, than three months prior to the day of Exhibition; and all Grain, Root Crops, or other articles whatever exhibited, must have been grown or manufactured by the competitor or directly under his superintendence, within the year in which such articles are exhibited; and all Manufactures shall be perfectly new.

No person shall be allowed to exhibit any animal in two fold capacity, nor receive more than one premium on animals or articles of the same FERNIE, BROTHERS & Co., Orange Court, Castle St., form an Illustrated Gallery of the Naval and Military 0 kind or class.

Arrangements will be made on the ground for the safe keeping of all animals, exhibited, and halters must be furnished by the owners.

Animals and articles for exhibition must be entered with the Secretary not later than the Saturday previous to the day of the Show, who will present each competitor with a numbered card corresponding to the entry in his book, which must 6 be attached to the articles when exhibited.

All animals and articles for exhibition must be on the ground by 10 o'clock, A. M., when a Committee will be in attendance to assign to each its proper place, where it must remain till the close of 6 the Exhibition.

The Committee are requested to be on the ground, on the morning of the Snow, by nine o'lock, for making the necessary arrangements .-The exhibition will open at 10 o'clock.

Competent Judges will be appointed on mornng of the Show, who will be at liberty to withnold any premium, if the animal or article be deicient in merit.

Should any member violate the rules of the Society, he will exclude himself from receiving any remium.

No person shall be allowed to interfere with the Judges in the discharge of their duties, nor meddle with any animal or article exhibited, nor remain in the place where the Exhibition is held, unless at the request of the Judges.
