Tiberius, at his death, left £23,625,000, which Caligula spent in less than twelve months. Vespasian, on ascending the throne estimated all the expenses of the State at £35,000,-000. The debts of Milo amounted to £600,000 .--Cæsar, before he entered upon any office, owed £2,-995,000. He purchased the friendship of Curio for £500.000, and that of Lucius Paulus for £300, 000. 




