Suggestion about Farmers' Clubs.

Although nothing new can be said upon this topic, it is a good season of the year to again bring to the notice of our readers the importance of these meetings.

1. The farmers' club should be found flourishing wherever two neighbors live. The meetings may be held at evening or during the day time, by the way side or in the field, under orchard trees or by the hearthstone.

2. Those farmers' clubs, regularly organized, succeed best if there is as little formality as possible in their proceedings, consistent with proper order and decorum.

3. The life, spirit and interest of the farmers' club is conversation. Plain, farmer-like talk is what is wanted.

4. A library is an indispensable part of every well organized society. This can be composed of agricultural journals, transactions of agricultural societies, standard works upon the various topics of farm and rural affairs.

5. Having drawn out of items to "fifthly" we will now draw to a close. Need we urge upon our readers, at this exact time, the establishment of these clubs?

RED THAT WILL NOT FADE.—Noticing in two late issues of the Rural inquires for coloring red on cotton that will not fade, I send you one that has been thoroughly tried by myself and neighbors with perfect success.

COTTON.—Fast Blue.—To a tub of cold water add one-fourth pound of copperas, dissolved; three spoonfuls of muriatic acid. Give five turns and wring out.

WOOLEN DYING.—Yellow.—Take as much quercitron as a person can hold in the hand for every pound of goods.

Orange.—Dyed same as yellow, and in the same dye add about one tablespoonful of ground cochineal, and bring to a boil; then add muriate of tin and cream of tartar as before; then enter goods and boil slowly for fifteen or twenty minutes, and if not dark enough add more cochineal.

SCARLET.—For every pound of goods you want from one to one and a half ounces of cochineal, and the same of lac dye; add about two-thirds of the lac and one-third of the cochineal and a little quercitron for the first dip; bring to a boil and add one tablespoonful of cream of tartar and one-third of a teaspoonful of muriate of tin; boil for five minutes and then enter goods for twenty or thirty minutes. Take out and add the balance of cochineal and lac, and proceed as before; add the same quantity of muriate of tin and cream of tartar.—Rinse thoroughly in cold water all fancy colors as soon as taken from the dye.

MURIATE OF TIN.—Take four parts of muriatic acid and one of sulphuric acid; mix slowly. Kill with grained tin. To be made several days before wanted for use. Tin is grained by melting pure or block tin and holding it some four feet above a pan of water and pouring it in slowly.
