There is an impression abroad among our contemporaries that a general election will take place before many weeks. We confess not to understand the wisdom of such a step, or the necessity for it. If the government should find itself unable to sustain itself during the coming session, by a presentation of a clean record, so far as the finances are concerned; and by the introduction of such measures as the Country requires, then they had better gracefully retire, and allow others in the Legislature to try their hands at "cabinet making" and sustaining. Now, that the natural term of the present House of Assembly is near up, it would be just as well to allow it to die a natural death; indeed we think this will be allowed, as probably neither party will be desirous for an appeal to the people, which would result, doubtless, in a very great change in the membership. There never was a better opportunity presented for the exercise of administrative talent than now; and a man of the right stamp, with nerve, knowledge of human nature and practical ability, might so reconcile conflicting elements as to bring order out of the chaos into which the government appears to have fallen, and save the failing fortunes of our present Legislature. Let us hope that March will develop such an one. We observe by the *Farmer* that the Government is charged with being too reticent in communicating to the press important information which should be made public, and which would better the standing of the Government. The same paper intimates that there is a disposition on the part of the Executive, to withhold entirely all passage from the general press, and centre all in the *Royal Gazette*. This, so far as the press is concerned, is a matter of small moment, but it involves very seriously the public convenience, the public information and the public finances.

We think the time has come when the *Royal Gazette*, as a monopoly should be discarded, and all public printing, including the "official organ" of the Province, to be done by contract, to be renewed yearly, or to extend over a limited term of years. There is a class of advertising that should not be confined to one paper, but should be given to the papers, local to the district affected by, or interested in the advertisement. This applies to the Crown Land advertising. It is absurd, the practice of confining them to that paper at all. It would be quite sufficient to make them much more effective, to advertise in the local papers the sales in the respective counties.

It looks to us as if those who assume a position of hostility to Mr. Howe, and the proposed arrangements with Nova Scotia, are unexceptionable. It is true that Mr. Howe's course, judging by all the light of facts which have been made public, has been erratic and inconsistent. But the point was reached at which Mr. Howe following consistently the views he has always advocated since Union was effected, approves of, and adopts the former course. He does it because the proposals made are fair; he does it to avoid the other undesirable alternative. Therefore, those who condemn him now, whatever their feelings on the subject may be, are lending the weight of their influence in the direction we have indicated—annexation, so far as Nova Scotia is concerned. If New Brunswick is interested in the perpetuity and good working of Confederation, she is interested in the settlement of the Nova Scotia difficulty. The interests of the two Provinces are, to a large extent, identical, and what strengthens one, in Government or Parliament, strengthens the other. Apart entirely from any consideration of present advantages which New Brunswick may assume to claim, based upon the concessions to Nova Scotia, the preservation and continued extension of our rights would be better secured by having Nova Scotia working harmoniously with the Union. And we present no one will question but that Mr. Howe would vary as much strength with him into the Government for the Maritime Provinces, as any Nova Scotian who could be selected.

Don't let us be misunderstood as charging disloyalty, deliberate and intended, upon all those who blame Mr. Howe, but we simply believe that they are virtually aiding and abetting that spirit, favorable to annexation, which is gladly embraced by some.

The *Saskatchewan Borderer* is strongly exercised over the resolutions passed at the public meeting held at Woodstock on the 10th. He will have observed before this, by the speeches delivered, what the assurances were upon which the terms of the resolutions were based, and will have recalled to his mind that, not only were the people of Carleton disappointed, but that the belief entertained by them, as to the route of the Intercolonial was held by gentlemen of high position in the Dominion, who are, we are satisfied, as highly aggrieved by the unjust decision, as are our people. We had that assurance, common sense and a reasonable reliance that the wisdom and discretion of our rulers should give, that the best, shortest, cheapest route would be adopted. Our contemporary must wear very powerful glasses if he can discover anything like a threat in the resolutions. We apprehend there is no need, as there is no disposition by the mass of the people to threaten. What is right they want, to claim less would be inconsistent with self respect. What is right they expect to get, to expect less would be to show great want of respect for the Dominion Government, and the *Borderer's* attempt at expansive sarcasm collapses.

We notice that some of our contemporaries are still discussing the probabilities as to the appointment of Rev. C. P. Bliss, to the position of Chaplain, to the Dominion Senate. We are inclined to the opinion that if Mr. Bliss desires the office he will get it. Of course he is qualified for it, and his department and standing is such as to render him acceptable to the honorable gentlemen of that body, whatever their peculiar denominational sympathies. As a New Brunswicker, Mr. Bliss' claims will scarcely be overlooked, because there is but one—We do not see there is even one—of the Senate who hail from this Province, and we are quite sure that the appointment would give satisfaction here.
