INTERESTING FACTS FROM RUSSIA The Russian Ministry of War has just published a curious collection of statistics relative It appears that in 1725 the Russian territories covered a surface of 275,571 square miles (85,687 in Europe and 192,884 in Asia), which has since been extended, chiefly by conquest, to 389,310 Russian miles (106,951 in Europe and 192,250 in Europe and 193,951 in E conquest, to 389,310 Russian miles (106,951 in Europe and 282,359 in Asia, including 9,680 miles occupied by the Caspian and the sea of Aral). This surface comprises the northern territories, which are almost barren and have but few inhabitants. The more fertile and populous regions cover an area of about 200,000 square miles, which is 32,000 square miles more than the area of all Europe. The population of Russia is unwards of 80.
