REPUTED THINGS FROM THE 'CITY OF BOSTON.' It was stated in this paper Friday morning that a bottle containing a quantity of paper, which had been cast overboard from the City of Boston, had been picked up at Casey Cape, a few miles north of Shediac. There is no doubt whatever that the bottle was the property of the 'City of Boston,' and that the paper was the property of the 'City of Boston.' The document in question was found on the beach by some Frenchmen, who, on being informed that the document which it contained was of importance, refused to allow it to be further handled, and carried it off to their houses, believing that money would be paid them for surrendering the property. On Saturday the Rev. Mr. Donnelly, R. C. priest of the district, learning the facts of the case, exerted his influence to obtain the bottle and paper. A telegram on Saturday, to the Telegraph and Journal, says: 'The document is now in possession of Rev. Mr. Donnelly, who desires thanks for the trouble he has taken in getting it. The following is a copy: "21st March, 1870.—City of Boston is sinking. Half full of water. No hopes. Take care of my boys." "Signed THOMPSON." Under the signature is written: "All gone in two hours." Mr. Thompson, Merchant, Halifax, was on board the City of Boston. He had a son in England, who was a great favorite of his father. A gentleman arrived here to-day from Halifax who says he would recognize the handwriting on the bottle, and would be glad to furnish information in relation to the document. This statement is very circumstantial, and we trust the document found may prove to be, in fact, a relic from the 'City of Boston,' and that the document is of great historical interest. It will not be surprising to pronounce upon its genuineness.—Telegraph.
