A few months ago the banking house of John Simes & Co. failed having only \$60,000 in money and a lot of wildcat mining stocks to satisfy liabilities to the extent of \$225,000. Many depositors suffered by this failure, some of whom were driven into bankruptcy in consequence of it .--The assets of the bank were locked up, and measures were taken to close up its affairs.
