It must, however, be ap-parent to them, from the support extended to Arabi by the notables, that England has in reality undertaken to crush the native military power of Egypt. The accomplishment of this task will cast upon her the responsibility of establishing order throughout the Nile country. This would mean the transfer of the protectorate of Egypt from Constantinople to London, British garrisons and English administrators, with the Khedive as a vassal of the Crown. The military aspects of the situation are not very grave, as the possession of the city of Alexandria with its splendid harbors is an immense advantage, while the army that can be brought into oreration from India on the one hand and Eogand on the other, renders Arabi's case hope-
