FOR THE CARLETON SENTINEL. LABOR AND CAPITAL.

MESSRS. EDITORS,-Has labor got a fair show with capital in our Government? Suppose we consider the facts of the matter a few minutes, and enquire into the working of both and how they effect our country.— For many years back labor has gone into the woods to cruise out a chance to try his hand to help fornish the market with the staple article of our country, lumber. He will with two or three helps travel several days, exploving roads to streams where the article can be conveyed to market; then to secure the ground a permit must be obtained from Government, and that permit must be advertised several days for capital to see it, disclos-ing the location and the number of square miles required. At the day of the sale Mr. Capital will be on hand to meet Mr. Labor, and will say to him, I see you have stolen the March on me, that is the very ground I intended to get, so the only remedy for me is to compete. Mr. Labor will say, it has already cost me over \$50 to explore it, and I more than its worth. Capital will say, it has cost me considerable, too, to ascertain its value, and I must have it unless you go to toil hard for capital at extortionate prices
