 DELIVERED in Fredericton, or on bank of the River St. John, or Tobique, one half to be thirty feet long and one half to be thirty-five feet long, trimmed and bark labor on, one fourth part to be no less than five inches in diameter at top end, one fourth part to be no less than seven inches at the top and in diameter and one-half to be no less than six inches in diameter at the top end and squared square at the top end, no sweep or butt to be greater than the diameter of the bark in the whole length of the pole, and no short crooked allowed. Poles to be sent as cedar telegraph poles will average. Poles to be delivered in months of May, June, and July.
