A BRANCH of one of the political parties in Ontario is agitating in favor of a Customs union with the United States. We don't see how the scheme could be made to work. Reciprocity with the United States on some such lines as that which is now being proposed, would give a free interchange of the natural products of the soil, the mines and the water—its something which is desirable, would greatly benefit our farmers and would not materially affect the revenues of Canada. But situated as we now are, while there are no duties on the importation of foreign goods, and no duties on the exportation of our goods, it is not possible to introduce a general system of free trade with the United States and with England, for that must follow of course, but to stop at any large portion of our revenue and a resort to direct taxation as a consequence. Right or wrong a high tariff has been established and under it large liabilities have been incurred, and as a country, whatever readjustment may be practicable, a large outlay will have to be looked to as a revenue from which to meet expenditures for many years. If the United States is sufficiently interested in trade with Canada to enter a guarantee to cover the loss from revenues which a customs union would involve, then such a union might be practicable.

HOWEVER manufacturing industries may languish elsewhere a visit to our principal establishments, the Wood Working Co., the foundry and agricultural implement factories of Council Bros., Small & Fisher and the Union Foundry Co., and the several carriage and furniture shops, gives one the impression that they have plenty of work. The factories are all working to their full capacity, and to supply either immediate orders or the constant demand which this rich and populous country affords.
