

Capital and Labor. Capital is the labor of yesterday stored up debt is the labor of to morrow, paid for and used in advance. The wise investment of capital is a matter of great importance. For instance, two men in the course of ten years earn ten thousand dollars. It requires half that money to pay their running expenses, or to keep them and their families alive. The other five thousand dollars is "invested." Jones invests his five thousand dollars in tobacco, beer, whiskey, theatre tickets, billiards and debauchery.
