The last brewery in Kansas has been closed. And still it is claimed that prohibition is a failure in the State.

Mr. D. L. Moody said at Louisville a few days ago regarding the liquor traffic: "We have got to make this business irreparable. The high license advocates take diametrically opposite grounds. Is it right? It depends on whether liquor selling is good or bad. Every position vice has been treated as reputable in some communities, and high license would make almost any abomination reputable."

A Good Resolve.  
Hugh Miller has told how, by one act of youthful decision, he saved himself from one of the subtle temptations so peculiar to a life of toil. When employed as a mason, it was usual for his fellow workmen to have an occasional drink of drink, and one day two glasses of whiskey fell to his share, which he swallowed. "When he reached home he found on the table his favorite book, Brown's Essay, the letters dangled before his eyes, and that he could no longer make sense. 'The condition,' he said, 'was such that I brought myself, I felt, one of degradation. I had sunk by my own act, for the time, to a lower level of intelligence than that on which it was my privilege to be placed, and though the state could have been no very favorable one for forming a resolution, I, in that hour, determined I would never again sacrifice my capacity of intelligent enjoyment to a drinking usage; and with God's help, I was enabled to hold to this determination.'"

A Drunkard's Plea.  
A Kansas correspondent, writing to the Christian Standard, says: "Prohibition prohibits more and more as years pass. It is to say that the law is enforced about as thoroughly as any of the criminal statutes, and is likely to remain unbroken for all coming time. Multitudes who drink, and who would create the law were possible, to get intoxicating liquors, are tried to it for the sake of their families. A few days since I was approached by a hard drinking Catholic neighbor, who told me that a druggist of the place was circulating a petition for a license to sell intoxicants under the restrictions of our State statutes. 'Now,' said he, 'for God's sake stop it, if you can. I expect to fall into a drunkard's grave one of these days, but I don't want my boys to learn to drink.'"

"This man is a fair specimen of a large portion of the drinking men of Kansas. The blotting out of the open saloon has been a great blessing to the young men of our State. In my quiet home, with a good supply of papers from different parts of the country, it is interesting to see how the world is moving on this liquor question."
