### The Amendment of the Incorporation Act

To the Editors of the Carleton Sentinel:

I saw by the notice in the last Press that the Town Council intend to ask the Legislature to amend the Incorporation Act in several particulars, one being the reduction of the town representation from 3 to 2 on the ground that there is or may be some prejudice against the two having while the other parishes have 2 councillors. I should like to call attention to Chapter 100 regarding county councillors. You will see that out of a council of 25 members in St. John's, St. John's City has 10, Portland 5, Simonds 3, St. Martin's 3, Moncton 3, St. Stephen 3, while nearly all other parishes have only 2. Now I hold Woodstock town has 2 more at the county board than it should have. Out of \$5,000 for county purposes the town pays 3, and at present the town has 2 of the representation, and I understand that the Mayor, who is also county secretary, wishes the town to have 12 for the reason stated, viz., prejudice. I am of the opinion that the town should pay the county a stated sum toward the administration of justice, and have no members at the county board. I cannot take out what is expected to be gained by repealing the 4 councillors act, unless it is to publish to the country that the city fathers don't know what they want; perhaps they think that the Legislature have to do, or is there a desire on the part of some to make the ring smaller? would it not be as well to elect the whole council by a vote of the town at large. There are some of the rate-payers who think that the Mayor should sit three years at council board, before being elected to the office of Mayor.
