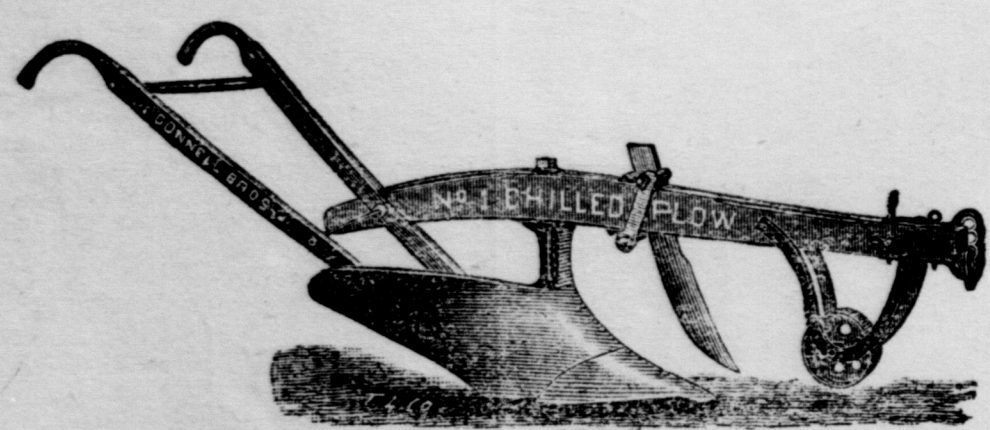

A TRIP TO ONTARIO

DEAR SENTINEL,—I thought I would let you know of a visit I had to and through Ontario: Leaving home the 20th of July I arrived in Toronto on the 22d. I attended the Council of the Ontario Orangethens and then went forty-five miles into the country and found a cousin named Hannah, that I had not seen since we were twelve years old, in the County Monaghan, Ireland. He has a splendid farm. He drove me around the section where he lives, which is fine farming land. The wheat was nearly all cut and in stock and it looked splendid; among other places visited was his son-in-law's flour mill where he ground from seventy to eighty barrels of flour a day. I then came back to Toronto and from thence up to Hamilton by steamboat, where I found other cousins, David and Charles Baird. Charles keeps a large provision and grocery store. On Sunday morning went with him to church, and in the afternoon, was driven by him around the city. On Monday I went to Toronto and on Tuesday to Kingston to attend the Grand Orange Lodge. The gathering of Orangethens was large. We were given a steamboat trip around the Thousand Islands, and in the evening we were given a great banquet, among the guests present was Bro. Wm. Johnston of Balikilbeg, who seemed much pleased to meet me. Next day we had a large procession, in which were six bands. Flags were strung across the streets with the motto on them, "Welcome to the visitors." In the afternoon the lodge closed its session and the brethren were taken in carriages to the old chief, Sir John A. Macdonald's grave, when a large number of offered prayer and we all united in singing a hymn. Next night I went to Ottawa: the fine parliament buildings there are well worth seeing. Hon. John Costigan did everything he could to make my visit enjoyable. After dining with him and Mrs. Costigan, he sent his coach and one of his men to take me to and show me through the Experimental Farm. On Monday I returned home well satisfied with my trip. We may well be proud of our Dominion; no true Britisher will want to join the United States, for we have the making of a better country than they have, I will now close, having already trespassed too much on the good old SENTINEL.
