

London, Dec. 29 -Gladstone Gelebrated his eighty-fifth brithday to-day, and was the recipient of hundreds of letters and telegrams past two years; these have cost a good health and spirits, and despite stormy weath-deal of money, and we are not told how er drove through the village of Hawarden to the church, where he met a deputation of Ar-Balsam.

The deputation presented a silver chalice to Rev. Stephen Gladson, son of the ex-premier and rector of the Hawarden church, in recognitions. nition of the interest his father has taken in the Armenian outrages. In reply to the presentation of an address, the ex-premier expressed his sympathy with the sufferings of the Armenian Christians.

Mr. Gladstone said : "Don't let me be told that one nation has no authority over another. Every nation, aye, every human being, has authority in behalf of humanity and justice." He had been silent, he said, because he had full confidence that the government knew its duty. If the allegations made should prove to be true it is time the execration of humanity should force itself upon the ears of the Sultan of Turkey, and to make him sensible of the madness of such a course as was being pursued. Gladstone spoke for a quarter of an hour, was remarkably deliberate in his delivery, and vigorous in action and geshis delivery, and vigorous in action and gestures, and was loudly cheered as he conclud-

ed his remarks.
