We are not interested in tobacco growing, but there is an object lesson in some of the experiments recently made with the weed by the U. S. Agricultural Department in Connecticut. Hitherto the Connecticut tobacco crop has averaged about 1600 pounds per acre, the average price of which was 20 cents per pound, making the income from an acre \$32. The Agricultural Department grew last year 2100 pounds per acre which sold for 70 cents a pound, making the income \$1,470 per acre. This was the result of superior cultivation, the product being equal to the best Sumatra tobacco. What has been done with tobacco can be done by farmers generally with almost all sorts of crops. Of course the cost of producing \$1,470 worth of tobacco was much larger than that of producing \$32 worth but the percentage of profit was at least ten times larger on the former than on the latter, and the experiment shows that "ten acres are enough" if they are well tilled.

A. Chipman Smith, one of St. John's most prominent men, died last Tuesday night of a complication of diseases, aged 62 years.
