

THE PREACHER-SHERIFF TELLS HIS WORK AND WORRIES.

The Pioneer, of July 11th, contained some interesting information concerning the law enforcing work of Rev Samuel F Pearson, late sheriff of Cumberland county, Maine, in which is located the city of Portland. At the last meeting of the Maine Methodist Conference, Sheriff Pearson, by invitation, delivered an address, which was reported in the United States daily papers as fol-

Sheriff Pearson placed a revolver, a razor, and two 'sand-peeps' on the desk, and then turned and faced the Methodist Conference at Yarmouth this afternoon.
