Notice of Seed Control Act.

A copy of bulletin No. 15 entitled "Bill No. 200, reprinted as amended: An act respecting the Inspection and sale of seeds with explanations and comments" has been received. This pamphlet is issued for general distribution for the purpose of serving as a notice to the interested public, and also to provide means for closer study of the Bill in its relations to the operations of seed producers, seed merchants and seed consumers. The Bill as amended by the committee of the whole during the recent session of Parliament, provides that seeds of cereals, grasses, clovers or farnage plants which contain the seeds of certain noxious weeds named in the Bill, will be prohibited from sale. It further provides for uniform methods of grading, according to fixed standards of purity and vitality, the Timothy, Alsike, and Red Clover seeds offered for sale in Canada.

A copy of the pamphlet may be had free on application to the Seed Division, Branch of the Commissioner of Agriculture and dairying, Ottawa. Letters addressed as above do not require postage.

MGR. MERRY DEL VAL.

Canadians of all classes will feel an interest in the appointment of Monsignor Merry Del Val as Papal Secretary of State and his subsequent creation as a Cardinal. It will be remembered that Mgr. Del Val resided at Ottawa as the Ablegate of the Vatican, his special mission being connected with the interest of his communion in the Manitoba school case. While in Canada he commended himself generally as an able and liberal-minded ecclesiastic. His advancement has been phenomenally rapid, and at 38 he finds himself filling one of the most delicate offices in the diplomatic world. The office has been filled for centuries by Italians. Mgr. Del Val is accounted a Spaniard, but, in fact, his mother was an Englishwoman, and he was born in London, and received much of his early training in English colleges, and is said to have a warm spot in his heart towards that country.

The new Secretary of State had attracted the attention and affection of the late Pope. Besides his mission to Canada, already mentioned, Mgr. Del Val represented the Holy See at the funeral of Kaiser William I., and at the accession of Edward VII.; he has been President for many years of Accademia di Nobili Ecclesiastici, the training ground of Church diplomats, and for the last three months he has given abundant proofs of his tact and knowledge of affairs as Secretary of the Conclave and as pro-Secretary of State. He acted for a time as tutor to the

King of Spain, and among other charges filled by him was that of Secretary of the commission established by Leo XIII. to examine the question of the validity of Anglican orders. Stranger things have happened than the ascension to the chair of St. Peter of this Spanish-Englishman.
