> Newfoundland includes not merely the island of that name, but a large stretch of territory along the northeastern coast of Labrador-the interior being part of the Dominion of Canada. Besides being an interesting province in itself it is especially so to Canadians because of its advantageous position, as well as of the Labrador coast. Without the province the dominion cannot be considered geographically complete and Canadians would not for a moment tolerate the idea of it ever being acquired by any foreign nation whatever. It is inadmissible even that Newfoundland should have treaty rights with the United States which would place Canada at a disadvantage in negotiating for reciprocity; so it is now thought that the province should be admitted into the dominion without further de-
