The Canadian art display at St Louis was badly managed, says a writer in the November Canadian Magazine. The furnishings and decorations are tawdry and far from attractive. There is no one in attendance to explain the pictures, there are no seats to invite the wanderer to linger. There are no pictures of our great waterfalls, of our capacious harbors, our beautiful forests or our more imposing public buildings. There is a collection of canvasses such as might have been painted by third-rate French or British artists. These pictures are good in their way, and would have been attractive in a local exhibition in Toronto or Montreal; as a representative collection to show strangers wherein Canadian art, landscape, nature and civilization differs from those of other countries, it is a flat failure. Value of Charcoal.

In his new line of research Sir James Dewar has found that charcoal—especially cocoanut charcoal—absorbs a large amount of gases when cooled to liquid air temperatures. When a continuous current of air was passed over the chilled charcoal the escaping gas was at first all nitrogen, and in a quarter of an hour the gas held by the charcoal contained as much as 60 per cent of oxygen. A nearly perfect vacuum was obtained by immersing in liquid air a tube partly filled with cocoanut charcoal.

STAIR CARPET.

When buying a stair carpet, get an extra yard for each end, which may be turned back at the top and bottom of each flight of stairs. The extra length will enable you to shift the carpet sometimes higher, sometimes lower, and so it will be worn evenly throughout its whole length. If this precaution is neglected the tread of the carpet will be worn in threads while the untrodden part will remain fresh and new looking.
