A WORTHY TRADE AGAINST VACCINATION.

To the Editor of Carleton Sentinel:

Believing your motive actuated by the spirit of philanthropy, in opening your columns for the diffusion of light, and as a faithful Sentinel and as a guardian of the life of the somnambulist populace unconscious of their proximity to the yawning crater of a volcano, and as I have not seen the Sentinel since the 11 ultimo, and do not know that any medical man has availed himself of such an exceptional opportunity to promote the public the Sentinel kindly permitting I thought that further comment and interrogation might be of practical interest. In the interest of humanity I will try to give some outlines of information by the way of illustration. We call to memory the old traditional effigy of blood-letting, prohibition of cold water from the fevered patient, the mercurial scourge that wrecked the constitution, burning the throat in diphtheria to cure a constitutional malady, all of which colleges taught and doctors practiced, as true and

legitimate practice of say fifty years ago. As the morning light shines more and more till the perfect day, so will traditions of pagan lore of so called vaccination, whose death knell is sounding, and whose epitaph is written on the tombstones of the slaughtered innocents. Should not the folly and gross ignorance of the past be a beacon of light, a monitor to the wise, and a reprover of the wilfully compromising the public health for the greed of self—money the incentive. Smallpox is supposed to have been introduced into Europe from Asia at an early period of the middle ages.

Doctor Jenner of England first introduced vaccine virus, so called, the 14th day of May, 1796. To what extent will vaccination protect from the contagion of smallpox? We answer virtually as the vulture covers and devours the lamb. The natural tendency of infusing such filth, malignant filth, in the blood is to corrupt and putrefy it, and if there be not a sufficient discharge of that malignity by the place of incision or elsewhere it lays a foundation for many dangerous diseases.

The vaccine delusion is a proof of the gullibility and credulity of mankind. To propitiate the small-pox demon so that his anger may be appeased they would offer up the helpless babes in the rite of vaccination, even though in so doing many a poor victim falls beneath the wheels of this advancing juggernaut and perishes by acute or chronic blood poisoning. Here statistics remind us of the fatal risk of vaccination, the facts of which were brought out in public inquiry instituted by the English government concerning the death of several children, which was charged to vaccination, and it was shown that four cases of erysipelas resulting in death, and nine cases of sickness by blood poisoning as indicated by various acute skin diseases, fever could be traced directly to the work of the public vaccinator. Erysipelas is what may be called a natural accompaniment of vaccination. The registrar general's returns of England give a total of three hundred and ninety cases of death from erysipelas after vaccination during 1860—80. The medical journal records hundreds of cases. A physician writing in the medical record reports five cases of erysipelas, following vaccination, in the children of one family. Death of a girl of 22 from septicemia. After vaccination from the same sore, six or seven other children passing through severe forms of blood poisoning, and two fatal cases of puerperal fever resulting from contagion carried by a nurse who had attended the dead girl. Doctor Jenner's mutual friend and biographer states that he inoculated his own son when a year and a half old with swine pox and within three years he was repeatedly inoculated with smallpox. His son was always delicate in health and died of pulmonary consumption. It would require a large volume to contain the authentic account of serious disasters from vaccination, which could be gathered from the records of the daily and medical journals from government reports and from the published experiences of physicians, but only the immediate evil results would be thus made known, and we should not have and can never have any adequate knowledge of the vast number of cases of chronic blood poisoning causing ill health and premature death thus originated. The reader will notice that I spoke of the so called vaccine, not from the cow as the word vaca implies, which is virtually false and misleading, but from a malignant sore, on the heel of the horse, called grease pox, a much less elegant phrase but never the less true.

Dunlop's Medical Dictionary page 434 says: Doctor Heim asserts there are no less than five kinds of spurious cow pox, all communicable by inoculation from the tits of the animal to the human body. It follows that in having recourse from time to time to lymph, recently obtained from the cow, it should be such lymph only as results from inoculation of the cow with smallpox. Eminent doctors of the United States, whose authenticity is unquestionable, assert that there are not only five but twenty different species of this malignant micro organism called (grease pox variola aquina the horse). A putrid sore on the heel of the horse engrafted upon the udder of the cow from the hands of the milker, who doctored the heels of the horse hence upon the human animal and so passed on laden with sloughing festering filth of a century's accumulation. All the protection we have against smallpox comes from our improved knowledge of the hygiene of the person, the home, and the community, and if one quarter of the money now spent to support a vaccination aristocracy was applied to improving the condition of life in localities where smallpox usually originates we would not only banish it, but with it all other zymotic diseases. Again I ask how many have died of small-

pox in the last year? How many have died from the effects of vaccination? How much has vaccination cost the province in the last year? Will we contract epidemic diseases? If the blood is pure will the grease pox virus taken from a malignant sore and introduced into impure blood purify it?

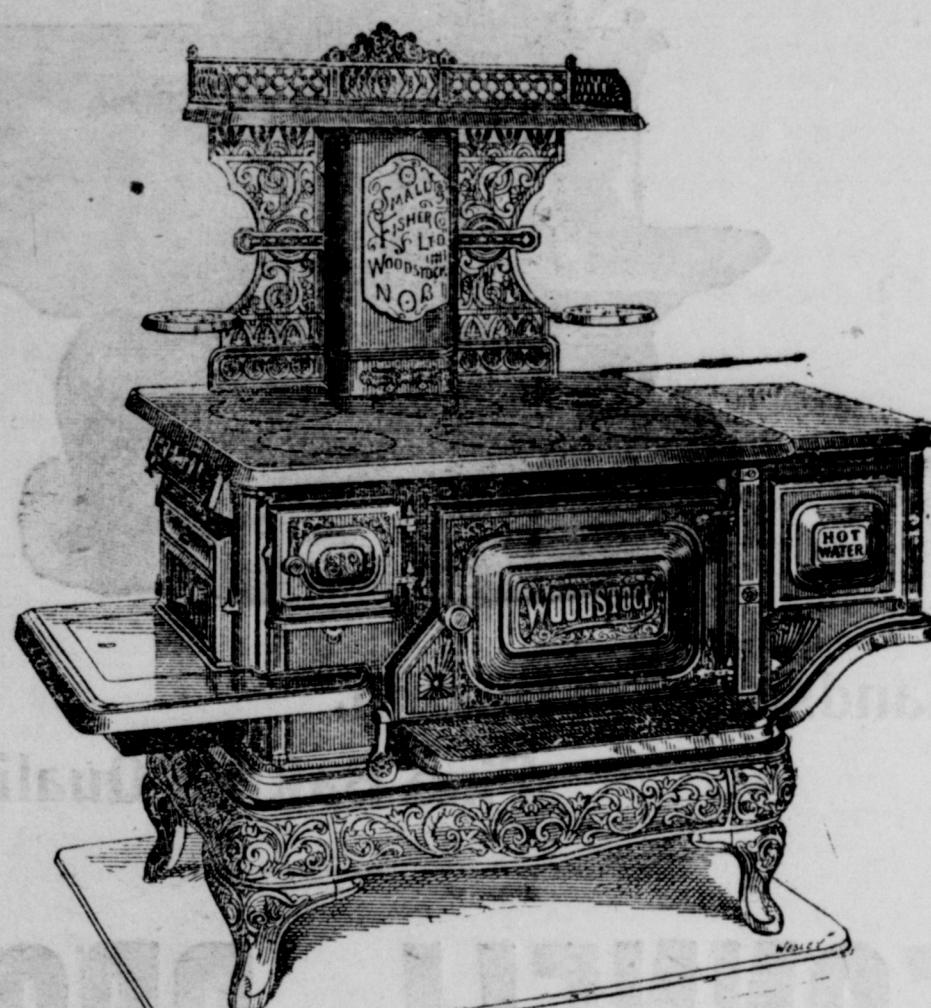
