THE TWO SCHEMES.

When the Opposition has said all they can say, the fact remains that the Government's agreement with the Grand Trunk Pacific is out of sight more favorable for the country than that made by the Tories with the Canadian Pacific. Their reply to this is that the Canadian Pacific was a pioneer line. They forget that, before they transferred it to the present company, the project had been in the hands of the Government for ten years, that the Government had built most of the really difficult portions, and that men like Sir Sanford Fleming were sure it was destined to be a profitable enterprise. The Grand Trunk is a pioneer line too in the sense that it will pass wholly through virgin territory. Here, in condensed form, is a comparison of the salient features of the two agreements:—

C. P. R.

Land Subsidy—25,000,000 acres.

Cash Subsidy—\$25,000,000; also \$37,700,000 in the form of sections built by Government. The whole line handed over as a gift to the company.

G. T. P.

Not an acre. Nil. Government construction of section, Moncton to Winnipeg. To be leased to company at 3 per cent. At end of 50 years line reverts to Government. Government guarantee on remainder of road. Running rights to all other companies on terms to be fixed by Government.

Monopoly—For 20 years no competing road south of main line to be built; this, to prevent competition by American roads.

Company to pay duty on all imported material. No exemptions. Customs Exemption—Company allowed free importation of all material used in construction. If, however, bridge and other material were bought in Canada, then company to receive from public treasury a drawback or bounty equivalent to amount of our duty.

Tax Exemption—All sites and grounds together with capital stock of company, to be exempt from taxes for 20 years, and grant in Territories exempt for same period.

Control of Rates—Company exempt from Government control till earnings yield 10 per cent. of cost of construction.

Country Opened Up—From North Bay along Lake Superior through Manitoba and British Columbia to Pacific, 2,550 miles.

Canada Has Money to Burn.

Ottawa, April 27.—The coffers of the Dominion are full almost to repletion, and there is no sign of abatement of the revenue. Money is still pouring in, and the high-water mark has apparently not yet been reached. For the nine months ended March 31 the ordinary revenue amounted to \$51,363,567, which was four and three-quarter millions more than for the same period of the preceding fiscal year, and \$18,642,313 in excess of the ordinary expenditure. Over all expenditures combined there was a surplus of \$32,082,443. The ordinary expenditure the past nine months was but \$333,000 more than for the corresponding period of the preceding year. The revenue from customs, excise and the postoffice shows a substantial increase in each case. There was a slight falling off in the revenue from public works. The following were the receipts in detail:—

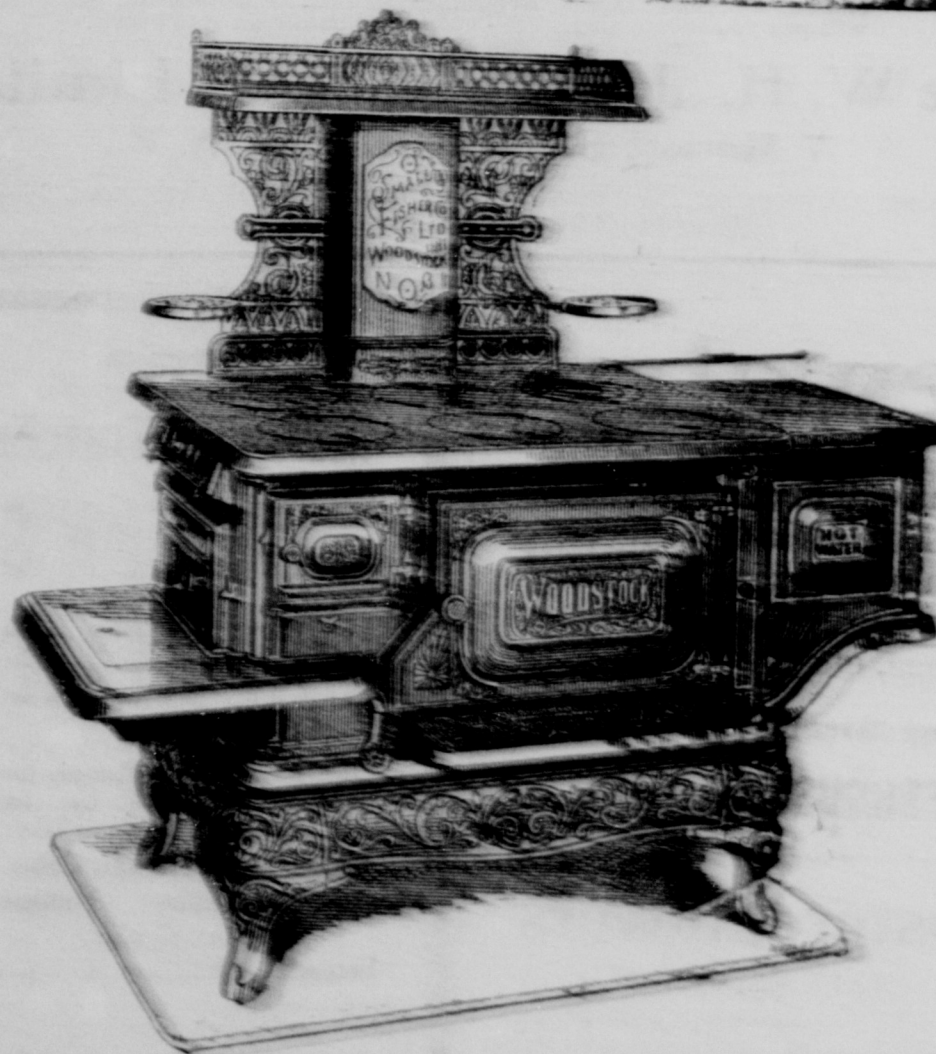
