## TOWN COUNCIL.

On Friday evening of last week, the Town Council meeting was attended by Mayor Lindsay and a full board of councillors.

Police Magistrate Dibblee's report for nine months showed \$262 paid in fines at the police court.

Coun. Stevens reported on behalf of the committee appointed to look into the safe keeping of the books of the treasurer. He had seen Supt. Munro and found there was ample space in the town vault for all the books and papers of the treasurer.

On motion Coun Burtt, seconded Coun Stevens, the treasurer was requested to keep his books in the town vault in future, and he be given any room now unoccupied in the town building for the use of an office, if he desires an office near the vault. Coun Burtt reported that the town scales had been leased to George F Smith for one year at \$75, the same

price paid last year. In reply to Coun Jones' query if

the taxes had been collected from the woollen mills, the town Marshal of Lieut-General Zassalitch of the answered in the negative. Coun Stevens made inquiry if the


On motion Coun Gallagher, seconded Coun Stevens, the street commissioner was authorized to take up all plank sidewalk from Chapel to Connell streets.

Terrible Losses of Russians at Yalu Battle.

St Petersburg, May 8-The emperor has received a despatch from General Kuropatkin, giving the report Russian losses in the battle of Kieu Lien Cheng. The report states that Major-General Kashtalinsky was injured in the head by a stone. The brunt of the fighting, General Zassalitch says, was borne by the 1ith and 12 Rifle Regiments, and the 22nd Regiments. The losses of the two former regiments in killed were four officers, including the commander of the 11th, and 481 non-commissioned officers and men. The wounded were one officer and 801 non-commissioned men, and a chaplain,


of the Yalu and the reinforcements sent from Liaoyang to insure its safe retreat. General Kuroki is pressing the demoralized Russians on toward the passes of the Motienling Range. He is now in possession of Fengwangcheng, the key of Southern Manchuria, and has forced the Russians to burn their stores. He will hardly, however, attempt to follow the enemy through the passes, in which a few brave and determined men might hold back an army. Japan's probable line of advance will be up the railway. At some point near Fengwangcheng a force will be left sufficiently large to prevent raiding. The greater part of the Second Army, under command of General Oku, and of the first, under Kuroki, will march west and north toward Haicheng, an
