### 700 LIVES LOST In a Horrible Disaster at Sea.

London, July 4.—Nearly 700 Danish and Norwegian emigrants bound for New York are believed to have been drowned in the North Atlantic, out of 800 souls, on board the Danish steamer Norge, which left Copenhagen, June 22.

The Norge, which had been on the Copenhagen New York service of the Scandinavian-American line for a number of years, was an iron vessel of 3,315 tons gross and 2,121 tons net. She was 340 feet long and had six water-tight bulkheads.

The Norge was built at Glasgow in 1881.

The Norge sailed from Copenhagen June 22. She was last sighted off the northernmost point of the Hebrides Islands, on June 27. Rockall, the islet on which she struck, is about 200 miles west of the Hebrides. It is a dangerous reef, with a rock about seventy five feet above water.

#### SUNK BY A DEADLY REEF.

When last seen the Norge was sinking where she struck on the reef, whose isolated peak rises itself from a deadly Atlantic reef, some 293 miles off the west coast of Scotland.

Early in the morning of June 28, the Norge, which was out of her course in heavy weather, ran onto the Rockall reef, which, in the distance, looks like a ship under full sail. The Norge was quickly backed off, but the heavy seas poured in through a rent in the bows.

The emigrants, who were then awaiting breakfast below, ran on deck. Except that the hatchways were scarcely built for these hundreds of souls and became clogged, there was no panic.

The Norge quickly began to go down by the head. Eight boats were lowered and into these women and children were hurriedly placed. Six of these boats smashed against the side of the Norge and their helpless inmates were caught in the heavy seas.

Two boatloads got safely away from the side of the sinking ship and many of the emigrants who were left on board, seizing life belts, threw themselves into the sea and were drowned.

**Aged Banker Robbed and Brutally Beaten by Masked Burglars.**

Rochester, N. Y., July 4.—Three masked men broke into the home of James L. Blodgett, aged 82 years, a prominent citizen and Banker of Hermitage, early this morning, attacked the aged man, beat him severely and left securing nearly \$500 in money and some jewelry.

The robbers broke through a door with a lighted torch in their hands and shouted fire.

When Mr. Blodgett rushed out the robbers seized him and demanded his money. He replied that all of it was in a safe at the bank. The three were not satisfied with this answer and again set upon the aged man and beat him almost into insensibility. They then gagged Mr. Blodgett and for nearly an hour ransacked the house, securing nearly \$500 in money, a gold watch and other jewelry.

Some time after the burglars had left the house Mr. Blodgett succeeded in releasing himself and notified the authorities of the facts. There is no clue. Mr. Blodgett's nose was broken and his condition while serious is not considered fatal.

### MAD MULLAH ON WARPATH. Has Six Thousand Followers; Many Armed.

Aden, July 4.—The so-called Mad Mullah of British Somaliland is again on the warpath. He is encamped south of Nugal with 6,000 followers, 2,000 of whom are armed with rifles, and has large supplies of ammunition and transport. Some of the tribes hitherto friendly to the British are reported to have joined the Mullah since the British forces were withdrawn from the country.

#### WHAT IS THE PEOPLE?

When they speak of the People they certainly mean something more than the whole mass of individuals in a country lumped together, says the London Mail. That is the People, a mere varied aggregation of persons, moved by no common motives, a complex interplay. The People, as the believer understands the word, is something more mysterious than that. The People is something that overrides and is added to the individualities that makes up the people. It is, as it were, itself an individuality of a higher order—as, indeed, its capital P displays. It has a will of its own, which is not the will of any particular person in it; it has a power of purpose and judgment of a superior sort. It is supposed to be the underlying of all national life and the real seat of all public religious emotion. Unfortunately, it lacks powers of expression, and so there is need of rulers and interpreters. If they express it well in law and act, in book and song, they prosper under its mysterious approval; if they do not, it revolts or forgets or does something else of an equally annihilatory sort.

That, briefly, is the idea of the People. My modest thesis is that there exist nothing of the sort; that the world of men is entirely made up of the individuals that compose it, and that collective action is just the algebraic sum of all individual actions.

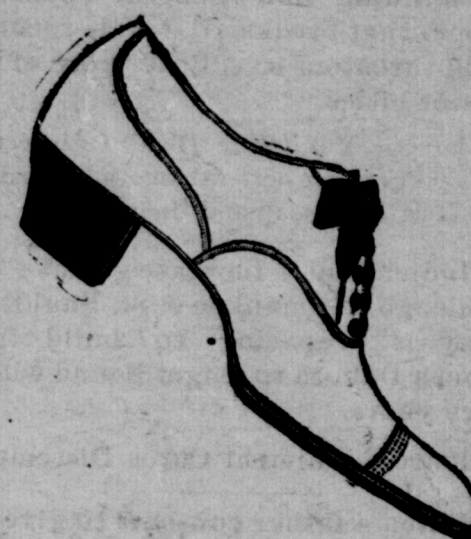
