EDITORIAL NOTES.

The Press thinks the sale of goods to the town by members of the council is a delicate subject for us to touch upon. Why so, Mr. Press? We have always condemned it, and now reiterate our opinion that no man should break the law no matter who he may be.

The theological tempest which was confidently anticipated by many, seems unlikely to materialize. Most laymen are wondering what caused all the flurry of the past week or two and the sudden clearing of the air immediately afterward. There may yet be interesting developments.

The few sore heads who seem bent upon annoying Coun. Leighton by making all sorts of excuses why he should not take the seat to which he was legally elected are really brooding trouble for themselves and their party friends who hold positions in the gift of the town council. The sooner this small second hand pettifoggery criticism is ended the better for all concerned.

The town council will meet on Monday. With respect to the right of Coun. Leighton to a seat at the board, we are of the opinion that he is quite eligible, and the council will be wise if it pays no attention to the cheap talk made by some of his sworn enemies. Considering the source from which the opposition comes we believe little notice will be taken of their hostile criticism.

Says the Press:—"If our esteemed contemporary knows of any members of Council in past years having occupied seats at the board illegally there was a time when it might properly have called attention to it but that time has long passed."

Well, well! A search of the SENTINEL files for the years 1903 and 4 would be interesting reading for the Press writer. These were opportune times, and on many occasions we referred to the violation of the law. Where was the Press? Shielding the culprits by its silence.

C. J. Milligan, formerly manager of the St. John Telegraph, and more recently in charge of the Victoria Hotel in that city, is to be manager of the new St. John liberal morning daily, which will make its appearance in a few weeks. Just who is to edit the paper is not generally known. John Lewis of the Toronto News is mentioned as a likely man. For some time he was with the Globe and later with the World before going to the Williston-Flavelle organ. His trenchant editorials in the News greatly assisted in the recent victory in the premier province. Should he come to New Brunswick and employ his ready pen in the interests of liberalism we trust he may be successful in the task of building up a live, progressive and true exponent of liberal principles.

We knew it would come. The wonder is that they held in so long. Here it is:—

"F. B. Carvell, M.P., since the opening of the House, with the exception of this week, was busily engaged in his legislative duties at Woodstock, Fredericton and St. John."

Needless to add this is a quotation from Munday's Press. Mr. Carvell has been in Ottawa from Tuesday to Friday during each week that the house has been in session, with the exception of one day. Everybody knows that the Ontario election campaign took away nearly all the members for that province, and by mutual agreement, business in the federal house during the struggle was at a standstill, so even if the Press article were true, which is not the case, no harm would have been done. We have not heard that Mr. Carvell has been to Enderby.

FRENZIED FINANCE.

Coun. Stevens at the town meeting gave the bank debit balance as \$3250; Due County \$1321; Unpaid Coupons \$904; Unpaid bills \$160; Total \$5635. Since the end of December, the town deposits at the Bank of Nova Scotia amount to \$1561. This would leave a bank debit balance on Jan. 31 of \$4074, providing all the coupons had been paid, but the facts are that only \$716 has been paid on outstanding coupons, so the bank debit balance should be \$3886. The actual debit balance on Jan 31st, was \$4868.

If the figures as given by Coun. Stevens were correct, how can this difference of nearly a thousand dollars be accounted for? The deficit as left by the figurehead mayor on the year's transactions was estimated by us at the time of the town meeting as about two thousand dollars. Fuller information proves that we were too conservative in our calculation. The deficit now amounts to at least three thousand and perhaps will be further increased by the time all the facts come to light.

A Great Game of Hockey.
