SYNOPSIS OF CANADIAN NORTH-WEST

HOMESTEAD REGULATIONS.

Any even numbered section of Dominion Lands in Manitoba, Saskatchewan and Alberta, excepting 8 and 26, not reserved, may be homesteaded by any person who is the sole head of a family, or any male over 18 years of age, to the extent of one-quarter section of 160 acres, more or less.

Entry must be made personally at the local land office for the district in which the land is situate.

(3) If the settler has his permanent residence upon farming land cwned by him in the vicinity of his homestead, the requirements

Six months' notice in writing should be given to the Commissioner of Dominion Lands at Ottawa of intention to apply for
