


Frost Fences Are Strong All Around

Homestead Regulations. ANY even numbered section of Dominion Lands in Manitoba, Saskatchewan and Alberta, excepting 8 and 26, not reserved, may be homesteaded by any person who is No other treatment for the nerves | the sole head of a family, or any male over

section of 160 acres, more or less. Entry may be made personally at the local land office for the district in which the land is situate, or if the homesteader ister of the Interior, Ottawa, the Commisstoner of Immigration, Winnipeg, or the local agent receive authority for some one

The homesteader is required to the conditions connected therewith under one of the following plans (1) At least six months' residence upon and cultivation of the land in each year for

three years.
(2) If the father (or mother, if the father is deceased) of the homesteader resides upon a farm in the vicinity of the land entered for the requirements as to residence may be satisfied by such person residing
