

To all persons whom it may concern :-You are hereby notified that the fallowing is a copy of the by-law establishing a fire limit within the Town of Woodstock and all persons will govern themselves according to its provisions,-

A LAW.

To Regulate the Construction Buildings and the Materials to be used in the Construction Thereof Within Certain Districts of the Town of Woodstock.

Be it enacted by the Town Council as follows :--

1 All buildings shall be constructed of brick or stone with gravel or metal roofs which may be erected within the following described district in said Town of Woodstock. which said district shall be known as the Fire District. To include that portion of the Town north of the Meduxnakeag bounded on the east by the Saint John river, on the west by Green street, on the north by Chapel street and Regent street, on river; also to include that portion
