

They are certainly wonders, performing an infinite variety of tricks, including a barber shop scene, where one elephant shaves another, and the final act as performed at the Hippodrome was "chuting the chutes" where the elephants slide down a steep incline into a big tank of water. In order to get these elephants into the amusement hall, which is on the second story, it will be necessary to have them, at each performance, walk up-stairs on their hind legs, just like human beings.




