SYNOPSIS OF CANADIAN NORTH-WEST

HOMESTEAD REGULATIONS.

The homesteader is required to perform the onditions connected therewith under one of

the following plans:
(1) At least six month's residence upon and cultivation of the land in each year for three

(2) If the father (or mother,) if the father is deceased) of the homesteader resides upon a farm in the vicinity of the land entered for, the requirements as to residence may be satisfied by such persons residing with the father or mother.

(3) If the settler has his permanent residence upon farming land owned by him in the vicinity of his homestead, the requirements as to residence may be satisfied by residence upon the said land.

Six month's notice in writing should be given to the Commissioner of Dominion Lands at Ottawa of intention to apply for

The ceusus returns of 1901 showed that there were at that time 285,000 sheep in the province against 308,000 in 1871. Showing a decline of 113,000 in thirty years.

There may be a number of econmers and sheep raisers of other countries not to devote so much attention to this industry, but here in New Brunswick we believe that the main cause for the decline is-dogs.

We could cite case after case of farmers here in Carleton who have abandoned sheep raising entirely on account of the ravages committed in the flocks by the mongrel curs that are allowed to exist, breed and flourish in this county.
