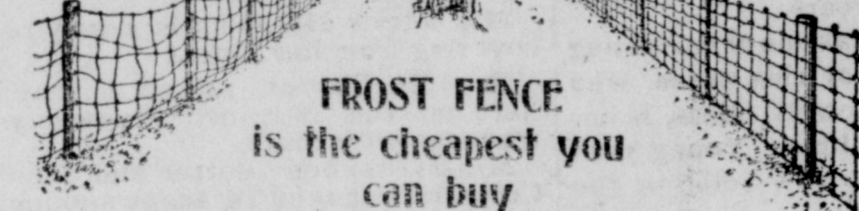

LADIES IN POLITICS.

In Canada the gentler sex seldom take part in electoral contests. Not so in the old Country. There the participation of females is a factor not to be despised. As an instance the bye-election held last week in Eye, one of the divisions of Surrey, in consequence of the resignation of F. S. Stevenson, resulted in the election of H. Pearson, Liberal, a son of Sir Weetman Pearson, by a majority of 197, over the Marquess of Graham, Conservative, eldest son of the Duke of Montrose. In the last contested election in Eye, held in 1900, the Liberal majority was 1,517.

The campaign just concluded has been one of the most lively of recent years, and was known as the "Ladies' battle," because the most prominent figures in it were Lady Mary Hamilton, who is engaged to be married to the Marquess of Graham, and the young wife of Pearson. The small Liberal majority is chiefly due to the intense popularity in the country of Lady Mary, who appealed personally to the voters and asked them to give her as a wedding present the election to Parliament of her future husband.

It would be a striking novelty to see the wife or affianced one of a Canadian candidate pleading in such a manner.
