Thus it is ever the way of life and the way of love. Selfish, immoral, shallow, unsocial natures may scoff at the sacredness and spiritual worth of human love. They may declare that it is a mere animal impulse for a selfish gratification and that arbitrary and artificial social regulations condition the formation of the family. Science may analyse human love back to the hungering of one atom for another but no man can take the sacred element of a mother's holy love and place it in his retort and tell its value. You may ask a mother, as she sacrifices all the forces of her heart and life for her child, what is the rational ground upon which she justifies her action and she will reply that if you were a mother you would not ask the question but just because you are not a parent she cannot explain it to your appreciation and understanding. Wait till you experience it and then you will know. She will say that love is the deepest, richest reality in her life and if it has not the worth it seems then the universe is a lie and may crumble into dust and ashes One might be a great scientist, a social philosopher, able to deal with the physiological, biological, chemieal, psychological and social elements in human love, but, if he were personally destitute of the inner experience and relationship which love brings, the smallest child which enjoys the mother's fond caress would have a richness and quality of experience that he could never know. A man whose affections were dormant might come within your home and tell you that it seemed to him a mere social contract but you could not convince him of its spiritual atmosphere and worth unless you

him a member of its life. ship with God.
