The Tightness of Money.

The tightness of the money market is having its effect upon all lines of business, so much so, that many of our wholesale merchants have been compelled to curtail the volume of their business, one of whom informed us recently that he had to refuse orders on account of not being able to discount paper representing actual invoices of goods sold. Others complain of having their bank credits reduced at a time when their business is increasing. Some of our building contractors, it is said, have also experienced considerable difficulty in financing of late. These people are told by their bankers that they have not the money to put out in their particular lines of trade, and that their funds are urgently required in other directions. We hear of one large wholesale house, that submitted a statement of its affairs to the Bank and although it was found satisfactory, the firm did not obtain the necessary credit. It applied to another bank, however, and got the accommodation it required. We mention these circumstances to illustrate the scarcity of money, and the difficulty some borrowers have in obtaining it. We have just heard of a call loan running at 6 per cent being called, and although the borrower offered 7 per cent for its renewal, it was refused, and we are told that this is not an isolated case. One of the chief reasons we opine, of the scarcity of funds at the moment, is the great expansion of business and the need of increased capital to run it, and this calls for increased bank capital.
