

Recently an expatriated Canadian. named W R Givens, a former resident of Kingston, Oct., wrote to The New York Independent, giving people. Now The New York Sun expresses surprise that anyone should be so ill-informed as Mr Givens has shown himself to be with respect to conditions in this country. The Sun says editorially :

"With the statement of this writer that "there is little real Canadianism in the Dominion, really no such thirg as true Canadian spirit," we cannot agree in any way. 


