A New Coin for Canada.

Soon after the opening of the new mint at Ottawa next December it is understood that there will be one or more new coins put into circulation. It is practically arranged that there shall be a new penny piece of the value of two cents and coined from nickel. This will be the first time that nickel, though one of Canada's greatest minerals has been made use of for Canadian coinage. The United States have used it for many years for the manufacture of five cent pieces. There is felt to be a need for a penny piece in Canada and nickel is to be used to save bulk, which is a fault of copper coins of the value of two cents. When the mint is in full running order there will be sixty hands employed. It is expected to issue between sixteen and twenty million Canadian coins each year. At the present time the royal mint in London is coining sixteen million coins a year for Canada. Next year this will be done in Ottawa.

The Minister of Justice.

The malady that has temporarily laid the Hon. Mr. Aylesworth aside from work is exceedingly regrettable. The office of Minister of Justice and Attorney-General of Canada is a very important one, and Mr. Aylesworth is exceptionally qualified to discharge its duties. He has good natural ability, a long and varied professional experience, and well high inexhaustible capacity for work. He is early and late in his own department, and keeps arrears from accumulating. During his incumbency he has been very steady in the capital and has, as acting Minister, repeatedly assumed the burden of other departments in the absence of the Minister in charge. There is a limit to the performance of duty on such a scale and Mr. Aylesworth has apparently discovered it. Much needed relief from a long endured strain will probably enable him to recuperate within a short time, but the warning is one to which he will do well to take heed, in his own interest as well as that of the public at large. The portfolio of Justice has always been a hard one to provide for, and it has never been more satisfactorily administered by any other incumbent than it has been by him. It is in the last degree undesirable that there should be any change now, especially on the eve of a session of Parliament during which important international questions will inevitably present themselves for treatment.

An Efficient Minister.

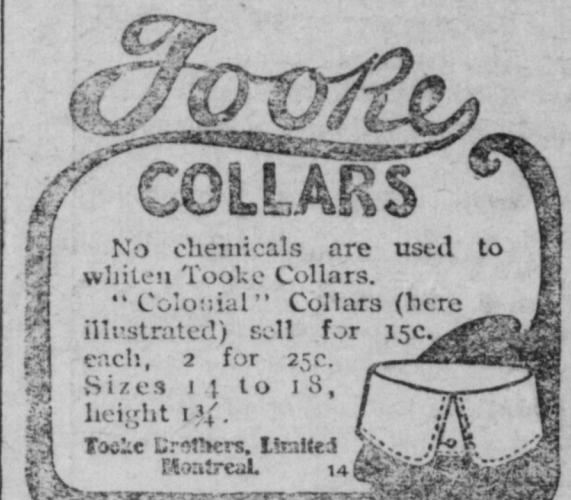

The Toronto News, which is so often quoted by Tory newspapers and politicians, as an eminently fair authority on public questions, has a word of praise for Sir Frederick Borden and his efficiency as minister of militia. It says:

"It has to be admitted that under Sir Frederick Borden the Canadian militia has been greatly strengthened and the expenditures for defence materially increased. No other minister, since Confederation, has been more successful in persuading Parliament and the country to regard the militia as a necessary organization, and to make adequate provision for its support. Under his administration the Canadian contingents were organized and despatched to South Africa, and under his administration we have undertaken to maintain the defences at Halifax and Esquimaux. Moreover, Sir Frederick Borden has represented Canada satisfactorily in various negotiations with the Imperial authorities and has achieved a satisfactory understanding between Ottawa and the home Government."

Judge Gregory and his son, Col. Frank B. Gregory of Victoria, returned Monday from a trip to the old country, after an absence of seven weeks. They crossed the Atlantic by the Empress of Britain, which had a rather boisterous passage, but the judge proved himself a good sailor and always manage to put in an appearance at meal time. The party had intended going for a trip on the continent, but changed their plans after reaching the other side and remained on the British Isles. The judge's many friends will be glad to know that the trip has proved beneficial to his health.—Fredericton Herald.

Henri Bourassa of Labelle, the fiery politician, has resigned his seat in the federal house, and is running against Hon. Adolphe Turgeon in Bellechasse for the local parliament. He will likely be badly beaten,—at least we hope so.
