
An Efficient Minister.



The malady that has temporarily laid the Hon Mr Aylesworth aside from work is exceedingly regret. table. The office of Minister of Justice and Attorney-General of Canada is a very important one, and Mr Aylesworth is exceptionally qualified to discharge its duties. He has good natural ability, a long and varied professional experience, and well nigh inexhaustible capacity for work. He is early and late in his own department, and keeps arrears from accumulating.
