THE COBBLER-SEXTON.

A few weeks ago Messrs McClement and Greer, the discoverers of the Northampton Copper Mine, forwarded a sample of their ore, through Mr F B Carvell M P, to Dr Eugene Haanel, the Dominion Superintendent of mines at Ottawa, for analysis.

Mr Carvell has just received the report of Harold Leverin, one of the chemists in the Department, whose assay is as follows:—

Copper, 5.27 per cent.
Silver, 3oz per ton.

Figuring the copper at 25 cents per lb, this brings the value per ton up to \$26.35, exclusive of silver. This, it may be stated, is a comparatively rich ore, far better than the great majority of the successful claims in the West. The authorities at McGill university have written to Messrs McClement and Greer, asking for a ton of ore. This will be shipped at once, and the result will no doubt turn the attention of the Upper Province mineralogists in our direction.

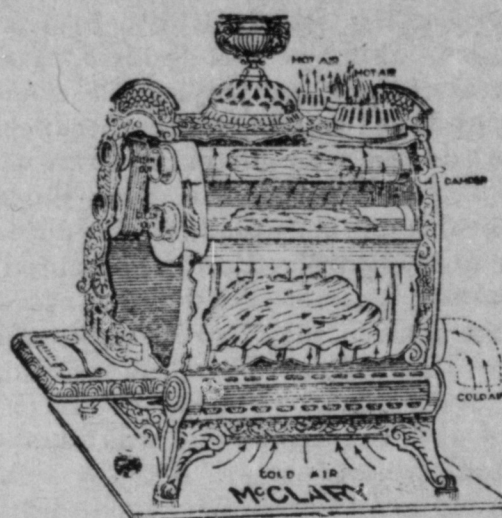

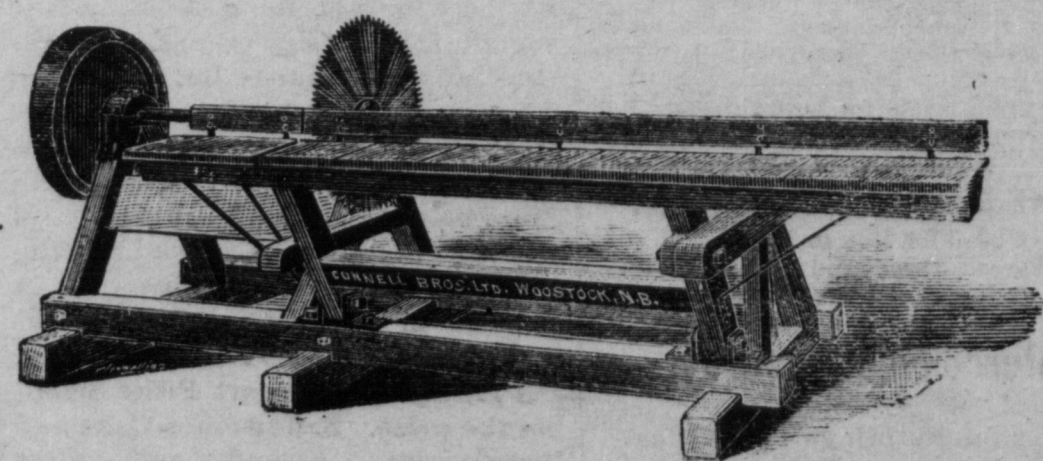

LONG TABLE WOOD CUTTERS

These Sawing Machines have a large and heavy balance wheel, 2 in. steel shaft, heavy frame, and long table with rollers; the table is part of and swings with the same frame that carries the arbor, so it is always in line. The stick does not pinch the saw when it cuts, and you save time setting up, only one piece to handle. The arbor long enough to cut off a stick over four feet long between saw and balance wheel.
