Jack McNair leads both Carleton and Victoria counties in the junior matriculation and captured the Victoria county scholarship. Hazel McCain passed superior with a high average.

Following is a detailed report of the examinations passed from the Consolidated: Jack McNair, junior matriculation to U N B; Hazel McCain, first-class superior.

The following passed for first-class named in order of merit: Annie Jones, Hollis Fiske, Jennie Darkis, Bessie Shaw and Ada Giberson, the first three making an average of 65 per cent.

The following ten passed for second-class, named in order of merit: Those above 65 per cent: Clara Jones, Rose Perley, Lily Shaw, Stanley Clarke, Muriel McCain. Above 57 per cent: Sadie McKay, Hedley Jewett, Katie Darkis, Jessie Waugh, Katherine Ryan.

The school reopens Aug 26th. The following staff will take charge: Fred C Squires, B A; principal and instructor in school gardening; Nellie B Harmon, first intermediate; Margaret Pickle, second intermediate and instructor in Sloyd; Jeanne Patterson, primary and instructor in domestic science.
