Application for entry must be made in person by the applicant at a Dominion Lands Agency or Subagency for the district in which the land is situate. Entry by proxy mays however, be made at an Agency on certain conditions by the father, mother, son, daughter, brother or sister of an intending homesteader. DUTIES .- (1) At least six months' residence upon and cultivation of the land in each year for three
