west Land Regulations A NY person who is the sole head of a family or any male over 18 years old, may home-stead a quarter-section of available Domin-ion land in Manitoba, Saskatchewan or Alberta. The applicant must appear in person at the Dominion Lands agency or Sub-Agency for the district. Entry by proxy may be made at any agency, on certain conditions, by father, mother, son, daughter, brother or sis-


ter of intending homesteader.

Duties.—Six months' residence upon and cultivation of the land in each of three years.

A homesteader may live within nine miles of his homestead on a farm at least 80 acres solely owned and occupied by him or by his father, mother, son, daughter, brother or sister. In certain districts a homesteader in good standing may pre-empt a quarter-section alongside his homestead, Price \$3.00 per acre. Duties—Must reside six months in each of six years from date of homestead entry (including the required to earn homestead patent) and cultivate fifty acres extra.

A homesteader who has exhausted his homestead right and cannot obtain a pre-

emption may take a purchased homestead in certain districts. Price \$3.00 per acre. Dut-ies—Must reside six months in each of three years, cultivate fifty acres and erect a house worth \$300.00. W. W. CORY, Deputy of the Minister of the Interior N. B.-Unauthorized publication of this
