

NEWS FROM THE WORLD FIELD.

Prohibition Movement Goes Vigorously On In All Sections of The Globe.

The latest advices from the busy fields of the World's White Ribbon movement note many items of special interest. The eighth Swedish annual council of the W. O. T. U., just held at Sundsvall, reports a large increase in membership and a number of local unions organized. The Swedish Parliament has just voted two thousand kroner (\$555) to the educational work of the W. O. T. U. missionary. Mrs. Greenman, had just commenced a campaign of organization in Italy, where her address is 13 Viale Elena, Naples.

Between seven and eight thousand people in China have been reached by Mrs Catherine Lente Stevenson, in eighty meetings held in twelve important centres, during the past few months. Mrs Stevenson writes that the psychological moment has arrived for the White Ribbon forces in China.

The New Zealand W. O. T. U. membership, has increased more than twenty per cent during the past year.

Governor Martinez, of the State of Puebla, Mexico, has heartily endorsed a movement for scientific temperance teaching in the public schools of his State, after a short campaign by Mrs Nellie Burger. Mrs Burger has returned from Mexico, but has received a hearty invitation from the Mexican Government to return there next year. The State of Vera Cruz, which is one of the leading states of the Mexican Republic, is also pledged through its Secretary of State to introduce scientific temperance teaching.

In Palestine, the W. O. T. U. of Jerusalem united with the Good Templars and other organizations, in a petition to the Pasha for the abolition of saloons in that city. The petition was translated into nine different languages.

In response to a request of the World's W. O. T. U., a strong appeal was recently made to Senor Arambur, for the adoption of scientific temperance instruction in the public schools of Bolivia, and such a law has been promised.

Prince Henry, of Germany, has just sanctioned the establishment of Good Templary in the Imperial Navy, and the first lodge was instituted at Kiel, with nearly a hundred charter members.

Over half of the adult population of Denmark have signed a petition to the Danish Parliament in favor of the enacting of a law, giving the privilege of local veto to every section of the country. This movement was conducted under the auspices of the Danish Good Templars, and the petition signatures to date number 446,000.

"Out of 3,000 natives employed in the Premier Mine in the Transvaal, it now develops, according to testimony given before the Transvaal Liquor Commission, that all but 171 recently voted for the prohibition of the sale of liquor in that section," declares William Hoskim, member of the legislative assembly.

Synopsis of Canadian North-west Land Regulations.

ANY person who is the sole head of a family or any male over 18 years old, may homestead a quarter-section of available Dominion land in Manitoba, Saskatchewan or Alberta. The applicant must appear in person at the Dominion Lands Agency for Sub-Agency for the district. Entry by proxy may be made at any agency, on certain conditions, by father, mother, son, daughter, brother or sister of intending homesteader.

Duties.—Six months' residence upon and cultivation of the land in each of three years. A homesteader may live within nine miles of his homestead on a farm at least 80 acres solely owned and occupied by him or by his father, mother, son, daughter, brother or sister.

In certain districts a homesteader in good standing may pre-empt a quarter-section alongside his homestead. Price \$3.00 per acre. Duties.—Must reside six months in each of six years from date of homestead entry (including the required to earn homestead patent) and cultivate fifty acres extra.

A homesteader who has exhausted his homestead right and cannot obtain a pre-emption may take a purchased homestead in certain districts. Price \$5.00 per acre. Duties.—Must reside six months in each of three years, cultivate fifty acres and erect a house worth \$200.00.

Old Coins Worth Little.

Age alone does not make the premium value of a coin. Many of the Spanish gold pieces, some of which have been in use on the American continent for centuries, are refused by dealers, except at their metal value, even though dating back two hundred years or more.

During the year 1898, after the close of the Spanish-American war, the United States Government sent to Cuba, carefully guarded by a fleet of warships, transports bearing \$3,000,000 in United States currency, which replaced many of these Spanish coins then current in the island. During the same year a New York financial institution, the Trust Company of America, sent by the less spectacular channels of express and insured registered mail a still larger sum. These two shipments supplied practically the entire commercial demand of the new republic, and put the Spanish money out of circulation. Some of the coins received in exchange were more than two hundred years old—ancient Spanish doubloons such as the pirates loved—bearing dates of the seventeenth and eighteenth centuries, and many of them made by hand. Yet they had no value except as bullion, while the common American silver dollars are now at a premium of 15 to 30 per cent in the island of Cuba.—N Y 'Post.'
