

Experts At Work On Airship

Washington, Dec 4.-A gun is being designed by the ordnance experts in the United States army for the distinct purpose of shooting dirigible balloons and aeroplanes. General Crozier, Chief of Ordnance, in his annual report to the Secretary of War, submitted today outlines of some of the difficulties which this

gun must overcome. "Dirigible balloons and aeroplanes move rapidly, change direction quickly, alter their elevations at will and are removed from any objects that assist aiming," he says. For short ranges General Crozier says it is probable that small army rifles or machine guns against the man aboard airships will prove most effective.
