





The applicant must appear in person at the Dominion Lands agency or Sub-Agency for the district. Entry by proxy may be made at any agency, on certain conditions, by father, mother, son, daughter, brother or sis-ter of intending homesteader. Dutles.—Six months' residence upon and cultivation of the land in each of three years. A homesteader may live within nine miles of his homestead on a farm at least 80 acres solely owned acd occupied by him or by his father, mother, son. daughter, brother or sis-ter. vinces.
