London, Eng., Oct. 27.—The Earl of Lanesborough has been appointed military secretary to the Governor-General of Canada, vice Sir John Hanbury-Williams, resigned to assume the Northern military command.

The Earl of Lanesborough, Charles John Brinsley Butler, was born in 1865, educated at Eton, entered Coldstream Guards 1888, major 1904, assistant military secretary to the Duke of Connaught, then Commander-in-Chief and High Commissioner in Mediterranean in 1908. The Earl served in South Africa.

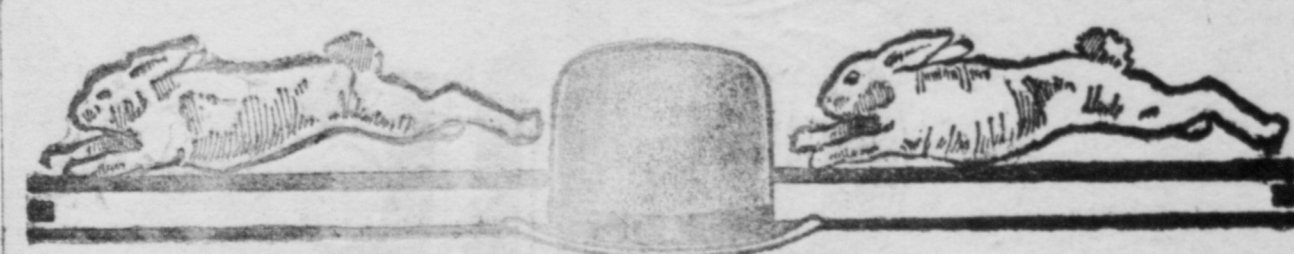
