



A special London cable says: A despatch from Berlin says negotiations for a commercial treaty between Canada and Germany have entered a favorable stage. Canada declares herself willing to grant reductions on imports from Germany of high class textile products, drugs, books, soaps, artificial flowers, feathers, wines spirits, ready-made clothing and porcelain, while Germany would grant Canada reduced rates on agricultural implements, typewriters, cattle and agricultural products.

J MacMillan Trueman, a St John lawyer has been in Ottawa seeking clemency for Downie the young clerk of the G S Simms Co. It will be remembered that Downie was found guilty of stealing nearly \$1,200 from his employers. A petition has been largely signed by the St John people and Mr Trueman has laid the matter before the Minister of Justice.

A Halifax sealing vessel, the Agnes Donohue returned to her home port the other day after having made a trip covering 20,000 miles. Her cargo of 4,000 skins valued at \$70,000 was shipped to England from Cape Town. While hunting for seals a crew of a wrecked steamer was found. They had been castaway for a month.


