COUNTY COUNCIL.

(Official Report.)

(Continued from last week.)
Coun Scott, in speaking to the proposition to give the papers the same as last year for publishing the reports, said that the people were looking to the papers for the news, and he favored the motion of Coun Tompkins.

Coun Melville—Some years ago we asked for tenders from the papers and we found we were up against a combination. They all tendered the same; if we cut them off we will have no report. If any councillor can show any remedy to supplant the present arrangement I am willing to listen to it.

Coun Balmain—The newspapers can make more out of the space they give to us, by using it for advertising. He favored the present arrangement. Coun Balmain's motion carried.

Coun Shaw moved, seconded by Coun Morgan, that the Hartland paper be included in the list of papers to be furnished with report. Carried. Coun Balmain, on behalf of the Finance Committee, made a verbal interim report. There have been some \$18,000 worth of bonds floated to the present time. They have netted the county, after paying expenses, and allowing for accrued interest, about \$17,500.

Coun Melville—I have been asked at different times as to the conditions of our loans.

Coun Balmain—They are sold at 96.

We will have a report tomorrow.

Report was received and placed on file.

Coun Smith asked as to items \$19.00 and \$6.90.

It was explained that these items were in connection with changes made in the heating apparatus of the Record office.

Coun Phillips, reporting on the court house, said that it was expected that it would be all ready for use at the session of the March court. There is now \$10,000 Insurance on the building placed by the county.

Contract costs of new court house:—K A Corbett, contract \$ 21,000 00

Fewer Bros, for heating court house by steam pipes 1,225 00

C I Churchill, for heating record office and front offices in court house by hot water 1,340 00

Electric Power Co to wiring building 675 00

Fewer Bros, to plumbing Berryman & Steeves for laying concrete floor in cellar 405 95

Coun Balmain—I think it was a distinct understanding last summer that a certain time would be specified when the court house was to be completed, and I think that time was at the session of the council the following January, and that a penalty should be provided to be paid by the contractors if they failed in the completion of the work within the time specified.

Sec-Treas—There is a clause in the contract making \$10.00 a day for forfeiture for every day after the time set for completion. You could exact that, but I hardly think you could show you have suffered any actual damage, and it is to prevent actual damage that these terms are put in a contract.

Coun Phillips—We spoke of this matter with the foreman Mr Edgett. He said the work could be rushed so, as to be finished within the time, but it might not give satisfaction, and we thought it better to take a little more time than to ask him to rush the work (Continued on third page.)

Big Reduction In Parcel Post Rates.

OTTAWA, Dec 28.—Among the matters engaging the attention of Hon. Lemieux, during his recent visit to Europe, were the parcel post arrangements between the United Kingdom and Canada.

For years past the charges have been 16 cents for the first pound, or a fraction of a pound, and 12 cents for each subsequent pound.

The rate has now been reduced to a uniform rate of 12 cents per pound with a maximum of weight of 11 pounds for a parcel.

Parcel post rates between Canada and Jamaica, Trinidad, St. Lucia, Barbados and Leeward Islands and British Guiana have also been reduced to a uniform rate of 12 cents per pound, or a fraction of a pound, the limit of weight for one parcel being 11 pounds.

The Leeward Islands include the Post Offices of Dominico, Montserrat and St. Kitts, the latter office being the exchange office for parcels for and from Nevis and the Virgin Islands.

These reduced rates come into effect on the 1st of January, 1910.

Canada's Population.

Ottawa, Jan 5.—The Canadian Bureau of Census estimates that the population of Canada at the close of the year was 7,350,000. At the end of the fiscal year the population by provinces was estimated as follows:

Since the close of the fiscal year there have been 150,000 immigrants entered Canada, bringing the total population to the figure first given.
