The southwestern coal fields employ about 25,000 men, producing 13,000,000 tons of coal annually and is composed of the States of Missouri, Kansas, Oklahoma and Arkansas. The operators say they are willing to continue the contract made with the miners two years ago but they carnot grant the increase asked for by the miners because of competitive fuel in the shape of fuel oil and gas and also the fact that coal is being shipped into their territory by the Western and Eastern non-union


