**Synopsis of Canadian Northwest Land Regulations.**

ANY person who is the sole head of a family, or any male over 18 years of age, may homestead a quarter-section of available Dominion land in Manitoba, Saskatchewan or Alberta. The applicant must appear in person at the Dominion Lands Agency or Sub-Agency for the district. Entry by proxy may be made at any agency, on certain conditions, by father, mother, son, daughter, brother or sister of intending homesteader. Duties.—Six months' residence upon and cultivation of the land in each of three years. A homesteader may live within nine miles of his homestead on a farm at least 80 acres solely owned and occupied by him or by his father, mother, son, daughter, brother or sister. In certain districts a homesteader in good standing may pre-empt a quarter-section alongside his homestead. Price \$30 per acre. Duties.—Must reside six months in each of six years from date of homestead entry (including the required one year non-resident period) and cultivate 10 acres extra. A homesteader who has exhausted his homestead right and cannot obtain a pre-emption may take a purchase of homestead in certain districts. Price \$30 per acre. Duties.—Must reside six months in each of three years, cultivate fifty acres and erect a house worth \$300.00.

**AN IMPORTATION OF LIVE STOCK FOR NEW BRUNSWICK.**

Mr. A. H. Thompson Bringing Out Pure Bred Cattle and Horses.

The Secretary for Agriculture, Mr. W. W. Hubbard, has been notified that Mr. A. H. Thompson, the well-known importer of live stock, will arrive in Quebec on the S. S. Athenia on the 22nd inst. with an importation of both cattle and horses for New Brunswick.

The animals are all pure bred and the importation includes Clydesdale stallions and three-year-old mares, and a number of choice Ayrshires from Scotland and twelve dairy Shorthorn bulls from English breeders.

The Clydesdales will be forwarded to Fredericton immediately upon their arrival, and offered for sale here.

During the past winter Mr. Thompson brought out an importation of stock which included some very fine specimens of Percheron horses.

Pullman Company's Newest Rolling.

It is reported on good authority that the Pullman Company will not submit without a contest to the order of the U. S. Interstate Commerce Commission for reduction of its rates. It is not so much the question of the differential between the upper and lower berths that will be disputed as the general effect of the decision which treats the Pullman Company as a common carrier and asserts that the rates as a whole are unreasonable.

This latter decision was based on the ground that the company was earning excessive profits, but the company's contention is that it is a manufacturer of its cars as well as an operator of them, and that as a manufacturer it is not subject to public regulation no matter how large its profit may be.

The question of whether a carrier's rates may be reduced merely because its profits are large and regardless of the value of the service it renders is one which has never been passed upon by the Supreme Court of the United States. It is significant that upon this point Chairman Knapp and Commissioner Harlan dissented from the majority of their colleagues on the Interstate Commerce Commission.

The ruling of the Commission on the reduction in the price of upper berths finds general endorsement. It is considered unfair that the charge should be the same for upper as for lower berths. The Railway Age Gazette commenting on this says:

"We have heard some persons say that they prefer an upper berth. They are decidedly exceptional. To a great majority the value of the service rendered in providing them with a lower berth is much greater than that rendered in providing them with an upper. On this basis it seems an unfair discrimination to charge the same for an upper as for a lower, and the commission appears justified in requiring that a difference be made in the rates. This is the view held by the users of the cars generally in Canada as well as the United States.

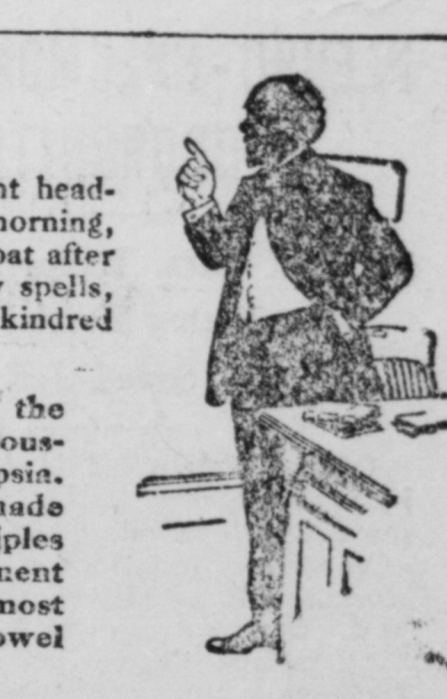
