FLOODS IN UNITED STATES

Cause Considerable Damage to Property—Many Buildings Are Wrecked.

Black River Falls, Wis., Oct. 9.—This town of 2,000 inhabitants has been almost blotted from the map of Wisconsin by the flood waters of Black River. Only a few of the sixty-one business buildings have escaped the fury of the raging waters.

What was known as Lower Town, that part of the town lying west of the river, on Saturday was a place of misery.

Many homes have been demolished, and recently several families share food which would not be enough for one man. Every grocery and market is swept away by the deluge. Provisions will come from the outside soon, but transportation is impeded by washouts.

Two dozen dwellings have been swept away.

So far as can be ascertained, there has been no loss of life.

Everything on the four business streets, comprising the heart of the town, has been swept away. The Northwestern Railroad bridge over the Black River at that point is still standing, but is swaying as though the heavy spans were supported only by cables. Train service is cut off at Black River Falls and no persons are even allowed to cross a foot.

At Hatfield, ten miles above Black River Falls, the river has cut a new channel. The main channel has moved over 500 feet to what was dry land.

RETURN OF STAGE COACH

Denver, Col., Oct. 9.—The stage coach has replaced the railway in Southwestern Colorado to accommodate the few who care to risk transportation over the flooded districts, a great area having been inundated for forty-eight hours, the result of heavy rains the past week, which has caused all rivers and creeks to overflow. The damage to town and farm property will reach into hundreds of thousands of dollars, according to reports from points in the flooded district. It is rumored that many lives have been lost. It is impossible to get any definite news from localities where the greatest damage is thought to have resulted.

Lacrosse, Wis., Oct. 9.—The flood from the Hatfield dam is now sweeping the

country just north of Lacrosse, and is increasing the height of the Mississippi River here at the rate of an inch an hour. Early today the Mississippi here stood at eight and eight-tenths feet above zero, a rise of almost four feet since Saturday morning.

That Black River Falls, which was wiped out by the flood, may not be rebuilt at all, is the opinion of many.

Mr Douglas W Clinch, secretary of the Provincial Guide Association, has been corresponding with the Count for some months. On last Friday he received a telegram from him stating that he would arrive in St John to-day, but he later telegraphed that he would be detained in Chicago for a few days. When the Count arrives in the city he will stay at the Royal Hotel, and later be driven to Perch Lake, where he will join Guide Charles Raynes, vice-president of the association. The members of the association are doing all in their power to make everything pleasant for their visitor, and it is weather conditions are favorable they have no doubt that he will thoroughly enjoy his stay in the New Brunswick woods. Mr Clinch stated this morning that at this time of year no better ground could be found to hunt the bear and moose than about Perch Lake, and that he was confident that the Count would be able to secure a moose before his departure.

CORONATION CONTINGENT

Ottawa, Oct. 9.—Militia orders to date contain among other things a copy of the despatch from the Imperial authorities to His Excellency requesting him to convey to His Majesty an expression of the gratitude of His Majesty's Government at receiving representatives of the military and naval forces of the overseas dominions for the purpose of taking part in the coronation festivities, which have just terminated. The despatch also stated that the amassing of the contingents from all parts had a good effect in bringing together men from the widely separated portions of the Empire.

A most favorable impression was created by the appearance of the troops on the Coronation Days, as well as at the parade at St. Paul's Cathedral on June 18, and also at the parade on the 30th of June, when His Majesty was pleased to present them with coronation medals. He states.

The detachment from the 79th Highlanders of Canada were inspected by H. R. H. the Duke of Connaught at Aldershot. This detachment was granted the coronation medal in the same proportion as was adopted in the case of the regular army. The despatch concluded: 'His Majesty's Government trusts that the troops will carry back with them a pleasant recollection of their visit.'

London, Oct. 10.—The Times confirms the statement that Turkey has agreed to allow free passage of neutral vessels carrying grain. It is believed that between 200 and 300 such vessels are now waiting in the Black Sea.
